❖ T-LPA Certification

Bianca Borg, Regional Planning Program Manager, informed the committee about the new T-LPA certification requirement initiated by NMDOT. The new certification requirement would make it mandatory for any person handling federal funds to be tested and become certified, before applying for funding.

Ms. Borg expressed concern regarding the new requirement due to high turnovers and member agencies having capacity issues.

Tisha Clarke, NMDOT, informed the committee that the new program is in place to help agencies. Ms. Clarke expressed that there have been issues with T-LPA applications and funds have been withheld due to this issue.

Ms. Clarke discussed the T-LPA testing, the training schedules, and the virtual options that will be available for agencies that have travel issues.

Ms. Clarke stood for questions.

There was a discussion regarding the new T-LPA certification requirement, the training schedule, and the concerns that agencies have.

Ms. Clarke informed the committee that she would present the concerns brought to her attention today to the secretary with NMDOT and that a new NMDOT letter regarding the new certification requirements would be sent out to clarify certain requirements.

❖ **NMDOT Liaison Report:**

Neala Kruger, NMDOT, informed the committee that NMDOT is developing a vulnerable road user safety assessment. It will be used to identify top safety issues for people walking and biking in New Mexico and help prioritize strategies to improve safety. NMDOT will be kicking off outreach and invitations will be sent out. If anyone has any questions, please contact Jason Coffey with NMDOT.

Ms. Kruger also informed the committee that an updated list with the updated information on which public agencies have submitted their ADA and Title IV Plans will be sent out. September 18, 2023, is the deadline for ADA and Title IV Plans to be submitted.

❖ **NMDOT District 6 Report:**
